CRIME ALERT – Burglary

It was reported to Vanderbilt Police Department that a burglary occurred at approximately 03:50 am January 21st at 1301 Medical Center Drive (The Vanderbilt Clinic – The Courtyard Café). The victim, a Vanderbilt employee, reports that he was in the Café kitchen when he noticed a person at the door with a handgun in his hand. Upon seeing this, the employee immediately ran from the area and contacted Vanderbilt Police Department. Vanderbilt Police officers conducted an immediate search of the area, but were not able to locate the person with the handgun.

At this time it is unknown how the person gained entry into the kitchen or what his intentions were. An investigation by Vanderbilt Police Department is ongoing.

Suspect Description: Male, approximately 5'10" in height, average build, wearing a black ski mask.
