**Subject:** Security Notice - Theft and Assault on Campus

On November 11, 2014 at approximately 9:50 am a professor returned to her office in the Stevenson Center and saw two men. The men had loaded her computer into a backpack and when they noticed her they fled. The men pushed past the professor and one punched her, knocking her down as well as struggling with another staff member before they fled the area. Both suspects left campus, crossing West End on foot.

Both suspects are described as black males in their late teens or early 20's and are pictured below. Both have slender builds. The male with the longer, dreadlocked, hair and wearing a white t-shirt is also a suspect in several other thefts around the university. He has numerous tattoos on his left arm and has black and red tennis shoes. The other man has short, close cropped hair and was last seen in a green jacket and camouflaged pants and black tennis shoes.
