

An incident of Sexual Assault was reported to a Campus Security Authority (CSA) today, November 5, 2015.

**A female student reported that she was sexually assaulted on October 29th by a male acquaintance in a residence hall after a party**

This Security Notice is being issued to remind students that:

- Sexual assault does not just occur between strangers.
- Consent must be clear and unambiguous for each participant at every stage of a sexual encounter.
- The absence of "no" should not be understood to mean there is consent.
- A person who is asleep or mentally or physically incapacitated, either through the effect of drugs or alcohol or for any other reason, is not capable of giving valid consent.
- Sexual assault is a crime.
