

On June 29, 2014, at 9:31 p.m., a man approached the cashier at the Taco Bell in the Vanderbilt Children's Hospital food court, displayed a silver-colored handgun and demanded money from the register. The cashier complied and the suspect took the cash and ran away from the food court toward South Garage. A witness advised they saw someone matching the description near 21st Avenue S. and Wedgewood Avenue headed east shortly after the robbery occurred.

The suspect is described as a black male with a small afro, approximately 20 to 30 years of age, 6' to 6'3" in height, wearing a black shirt and grey camouflage pants.

Risk Reduction Tips

- Avoid Isolated or dark areas
- If strangers approach, maintain a distance and be observant; if they are in a vehicle, get the license
- Report suspicious persons or activities to VUPD immediately
- Secure your valuables, record serial numbers or engrave expensive items with identifying information
